From the Pastor's Desk:

Believe in Miracles But Trust in Jesus

"Jesus performed many other signs in the presence of his disciples, which are not recorded in this book. But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name" (John 20:30-31).

As Scripture says, the seven miracles that the apostle highlighted in the book of John were intended as signs. They carried a message-proof that Jesus was who He said, the Son of God. These "miracles with a message" from 2,000 years ago hold great relevance for you today. They serve as signposts pointing to Jesus, showing He was and is God's answer to your deepest need. Jesus is the answer to your disappointments, doubts, disabilities, desires, despair, darkness, and death.

This sermon series looks at these seven key miracles, its overriding message is that God performs miracles-then and now-for one reason. "Believe the miracles, but trust in God. Their purpose is to deepen our trust in Jesus, not in the miracles themselves." The series will begin on August 8.
