Nursery is located in the basement at the foot of the back stairs. Changing tables are available in the nursery and the upstairs restroom.

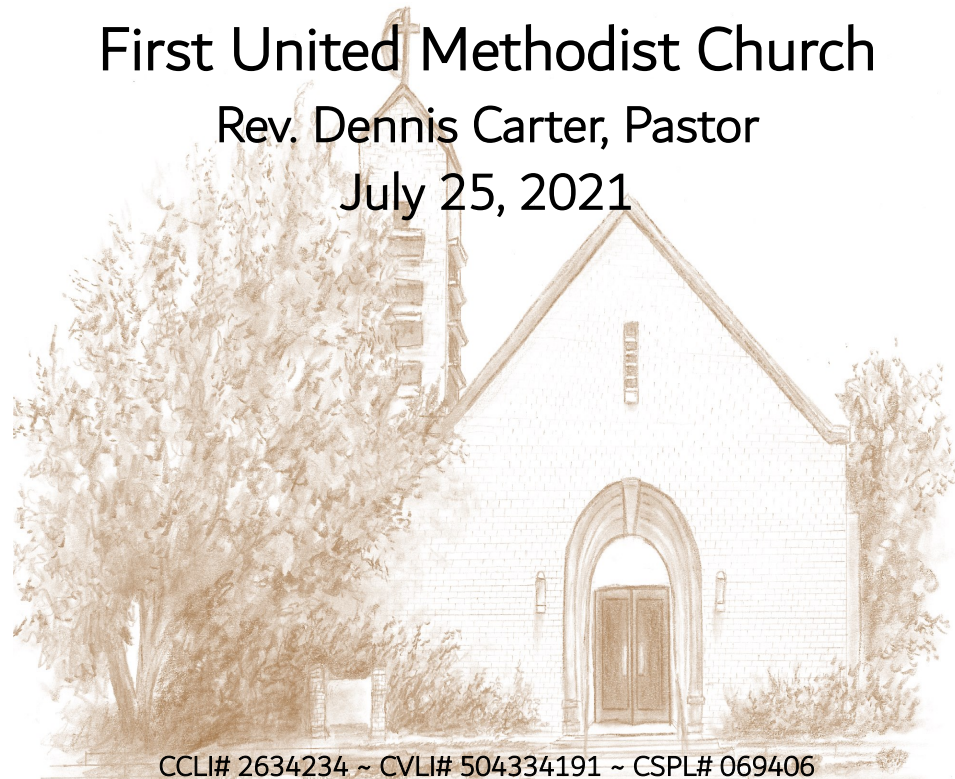
Restrooms are located upstairs between the overflow sanctuary and the parlor, and in the basement.
