Kids of the Kingdom— KoK needs cardboard tubes from the paper towel rolls for a craft. There is a collection box in the front foyer.

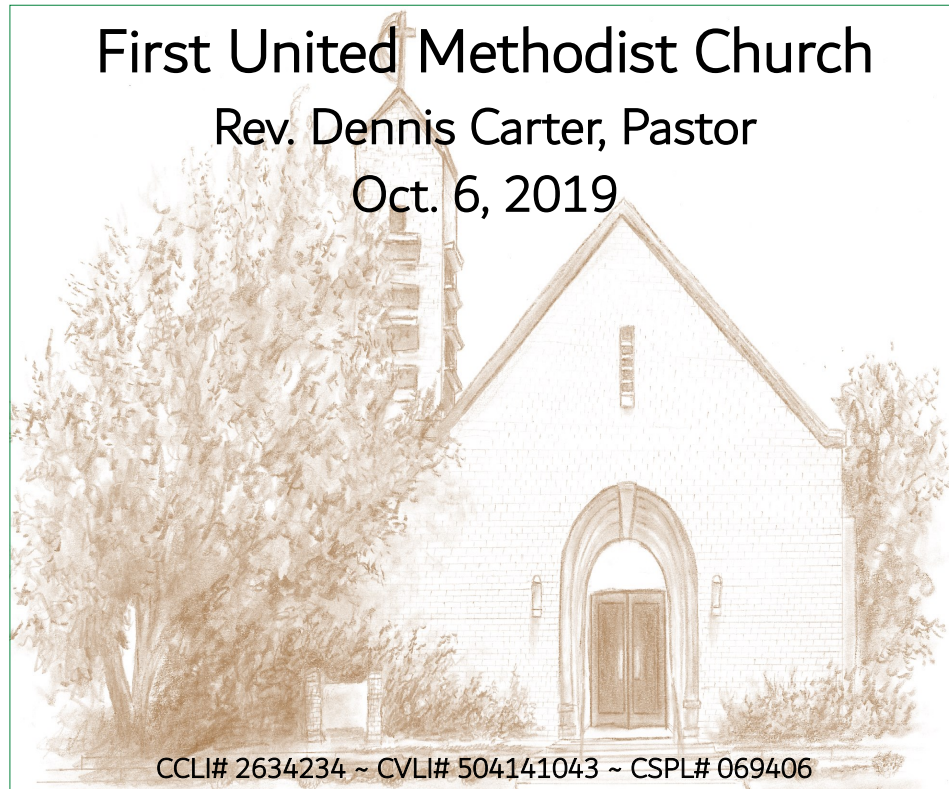
Potato Bar—Please join the finance team for food & fellowship at a baked potato bar October 13 following worship . We will be discussing financial plans for the office building.
