#### From the Pastor's Desk:

The Perfect Christian
"How Sinners like us can be more like Jesus"
Sermon Series on James

Can a Christian really be perfect this side of heaven? Of course not, but Jesus himself nevertheless commands His people, "You are to be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect." These words offer quite a contrast to the cries of our secular society, which has lost its moral compass and any sense of absolute truth. This ungodly age dupes us into thinking that being a tad better than the world somehow makes us acceptable to God. As Christians, however, we know that Godnot the world-sets the standards for us.

In this sermon series "The Perfect Christian" calls believers back to God's demand for perfection. The book of James challenges you to "march in a new direction in keeping with the perfect demands of our loving heavenly Father." The series teaches life-changing lessons on such key topics as: how to resist temptation, how to control your tongue, how to balance faith and works, and how to know the power of prayer.

The pursuit of perfection won't produce absolute perfection in your life, but I pray it will assure you it will mean a new level of spiritual life, power, and victory for you to enjoy. So please accept the challenge, make perfection your goal, and grow tremendously in your faith!

### Pastor's Bible Study: To Live Is Christ To Die Is Gain Begins September 9 at 6:00 pm in the Parlor

The study will consist of a 30 minute video and questions from a study guide. It will be a 12 week course that will last 1 - 11/2 hour a session.

Paul's letter to the Philippians is one of the most taught books of the Bible from the pulpit today and with excellent reason. The book is simple, straightforward, and broadly relevant-easy for all Christians to understand and apply.

Often people come away from this text and sum it up in one word: 'joy'. This both true and tragic. It is true in the sense that the letter is conceivably the quintessential treatise on joy that all believers must read to see the fullness of joy which Christians are intended to live. The letter makes joy real, practical, and alive and is unmistakably a vital part of this great text.

But it is also tragic to sum it up as 'joy', in that there is so much more there. It answers all sorts of practical questions for the believer today"

How can I share my faith?

What does it mean to live a worthy Christian life?

What does true Christian humility look like?

Where can I find true satisfaction for my soul?

How can I rejoice during tragedy?

What do I do when I am stressed?

What does a passionate follower of Christ look like?

Not only does this letter answer many questions for the believer-it also paints a beautiful picture of what the mature Christian life is. I pray you will enjoy the expositional teaching of Philippians-a book you may have heard many times-like you have never heard it before.


